The efficient staff of the school has been using apps like-ZOOM, MICROSOFT TEAMS, GOOGLE DUO, GOOGLE FORMS, etc. and is providing virtual lectures and worksheets to the students sitting at home. The school has its own YOU TUBE CHANNEL and teachers have also been uploading lectures on it, to help students in the best possible way.

The school administration is also active enough to cater to the needs of the students. Various activities like- Online Lectures on CORONA VIRUS by various expert Doctors, Yoga exercises, meditation, poster-making on Earth Day, Baisakhi celebration through Face Making

activity, card-making on Mother's Day, Father's Day celebration, Mehndi competition on Teej, Rakhi Making on Raksha Bandhan were also being undertaken by students through small videos in order to connect teachers with students and parents to build classroom communities.

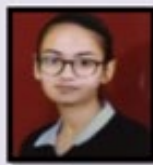

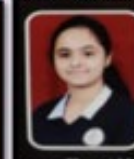

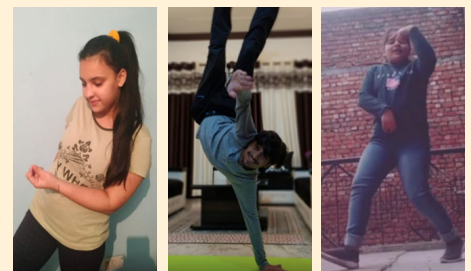
THE GREATNESS OF A CULTURE CAN BE FOUND IN ITS FESTIVALS

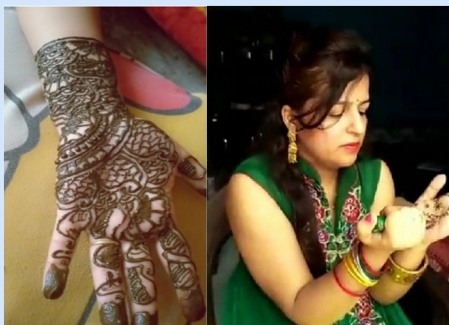
Yoga day celebrations go virtual among covid-19 restrictions (21st June 2020)

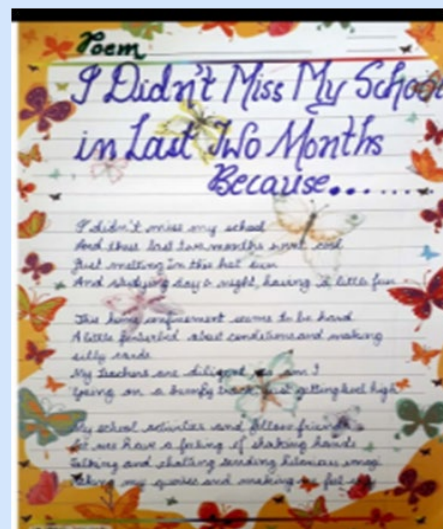

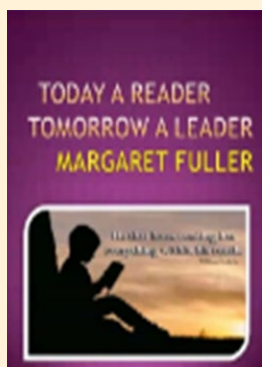
FIT INDIA CAMPAIGN BY CBSE

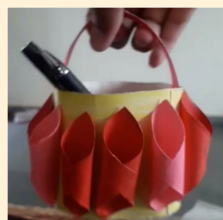
