Sh. C.K. Sawhney (Trustee-Dyal Singh College Trust Society, Chairman, SMC, DSPS, DSC, Karnal) a man with a unique personality, an epitome of perfection and educational excellence, left for his heavenly abode on 1st November, 2020. He was D.G.P. Punjab in the heyday of terrorism in the state in the 1980s and Chairman of PEPSSU Roadways Transport Corporation. He had a very long association with Dyal Singh College, Karnal, having served here as lecturer in Physics from 1951 to 1955 before he joined the prestigious Indian Police Services. He was Director of Vigilance and D.I.G. Police in Punjab. During his illustrious career, Shri Sawhney was decorated with the Police Medal for Gallantry in 1967, President's Police Medal for Meritorious Service in 1973 and President's Police Medal for Distinguished Service in 1981.

Mr. Sawhney joined as Trustee, DSCTS in 1982 and dedicated more than 30 years as Chairman of Dyal Singh Public School, Dyal Singh Colony, Karnal. His dedication, advice and whole-hearted support had always helped in the progress of the institution. His strong character was a source of inspiration for the staff and students of the school.

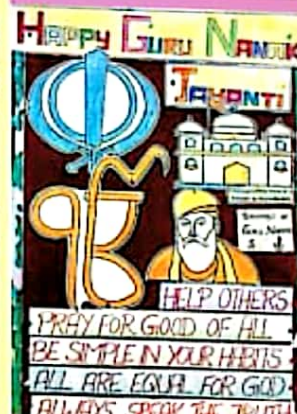
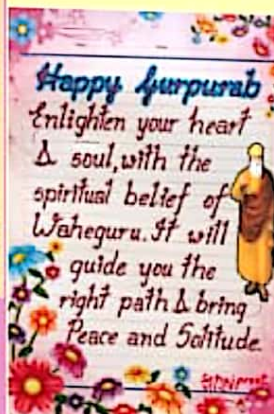
GURPURAB

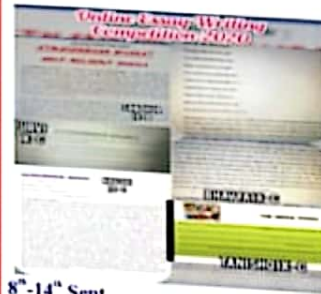

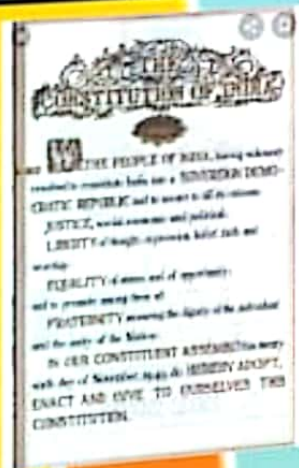
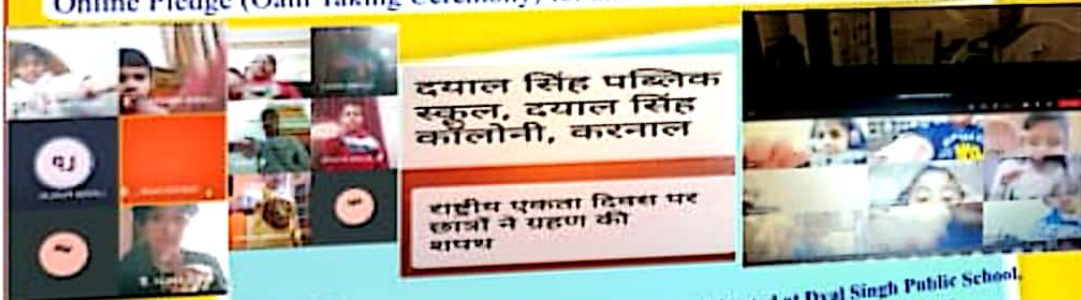
In keeping with the tradition, our school also celebrated the National Unity Day in a befitting manner under which various online activities were held which included -
